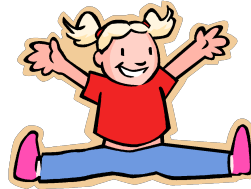


SCHOOL PLAYGROUND PROCEDURES AND RULES

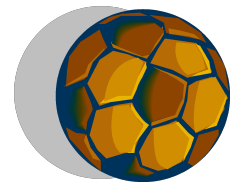


- Be respectful to all students and adults.
- Walk on the blacktop and in the tanbark
- Count to 100 on swings (1 Mississippi, 2 Mississippi...)
- Slide down the slide, never climb up. You must go down face up and feet first, and you must go all the way down—no stopping or slowing down on slide. Once you land, you must move away from bottom of slide immediately.
- Students may not stand next to slides to try to touch other students as they go down.
- No more than 3 people on horizontal bars at a time.



✓ **Running games**, including tag, must be played on the grass—never in the tanbark area or on the playground. The exceptions are games that have courts painted on the playground (basketball, BB ball, dodge ball and volley ball).

✓ The **walls of the buildings** may not be used as ball walls. Kicking the ball in this area is not permitted. Balls are never to be thrown or kicked onto the roof.



✓ **Balls** are to be kicked only on the grass. Once the bell rings, no balls are to be bounced or thrown.



WHEN THE BELL RINGS, walk immediately to your line—running in on the grass, walking on the blacktop and tanbark. Line up quickly and quietly in a straight line.

“When the bell rings, I stop. When the whistle blows, I walk.”
